

## SCARF WITH A STORY

This scarf, made from school time sketches by the children of La Petite Ecole, depicts scenes of the Vieux Carre, the beloved and familiar neighborhood of their school.

The sketches of these childrenso impressed a designer that she made the most interesting into a scarf.

La Petite Ecole occupies one of the ante-bellum mansions of the French Quarter located at 714 Esplanade Avenue, scarcely three blocks from the original site of the Ursuline Convent, the first school for girls in the Louisiana Territory.

La Petite Ecole is a primary school where French is still an important part of the curriculum. The pupils range in age from 3 to 10 years and have many interests in addition to the usual academic studies: A capella singing in French and English, Ballet, Piano, Sketching and Musical Composition.
